Managing School Attendance

Boosting attendance is a key factor in wholeschool improvement and is central to raising standards in education. Children need to attend school regularly in order to benefit fully from their education and fulfil their potential. Children with poor attendance tend to achieve less in both primary and secondary school. Persistent absence can signal a safeguarding concern.

Benefits to the school:
